<b>SPECIES</b>	Bacopa monnieri
<b>COMMON NAME</b>	Coastal Waterhyssop, Brahmi, Thyme-leaved gratiola, Water hyssop
<b>ORIGIN</b>	India; Pakistan
<b>DESIGN USE</b>	As a water or aquarium plant



**HEIGHT**  
25–50cm

**SPREAD**  
8–15+ cm

**HABIT**  
Is a perennial, creeping herb whose habitat includes wetlands and muddy shores.

**FORM**  
The leaves of this plant are succulent and relatively thick. Leaves are oblanceolate and are arranged oppositely on the stem.

**FLOWERS**  
The flowers are small and white, with four or five petals. Its ability to grow in water makes it a popular aquarium plant.

**FLOWERING PERIOD**  
Summer

**HORTICULTURE**  
It can be grown in damp conditions by the pond or bog garden.
