Bacopa monnieri Coastal Waterhyssop, Brahmi, Thyme-leafed gratiola, Water hyssop India; Pakistan As a water or aquarium plant



HEIGHT 25–50cm

SPREAD 8–15+ cm

HABIT

Is a perennial, creeping herb whose habitat includes wetlands and muddy shores.

FORM

The leaves of this plant are succulent and relatively thick. Leaves are oblanceolate and are arranged oppositely on the stem.

FLOWERS

The flowers are small and white, with four or five petals. Its ability to grow in water makes it a popular aquarium plant.
