DESIGN USE	



HEIGHT

Grows to 1m in height.

SPREAD

1.5m

HABIT

Rhizomatous, creeping, colonising perennial, grass-like or herb

FORM

Slender perennial with long rhizome; Rush-like perennial

FLOWERS

Bluish green foliage. Rhizome stout, covered with loose membranous scales. Leaves reduced to sheaths with a mucro-like lamina 1–5 mm long, usually dark brown on rim of sheath.



FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring through summer

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Prefers full sun; tolerate impoverished water-logged soils.

HORTICULTURE

Grows in mostly brackish or saline swamps, on sandy soils; in coastal areas; capable of growing in soils / water with high concentrations of contaminants and nutrients
