



SPECIES	Baumea teretifolia
COMMON NAME	Pakihi rush
ORIGIN	Australia
DESIGN USE	Revegetation of wetland and wastewater treatment, textural planting



HEIGHT

1m-1.5m

SPREAD

1.5m-5m

HABIT

Perennial with long rhizome.

FORM

Sedge and rush like

FLOWERS

A panicle which is held erect and high amongst the foliage, 4 - 20 cm long by 2.5 - 3.5 cm wide, dark brown or black

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring - Summer

FRUIT

Round white/grey with longitudinal wrinkles.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Prefers very wet conditions and plenty of space in full sun or partial shade.

HORTICULTURE

Are particularly capable of growing in soils or water with high concentrations of contaminants and nutrients.
