COMMON NAME	Knobby club rush
ORIGIN	New South Wales; Victoria
DESIGN USE	Ornamental grass ideal planting around ponds.



HEIGHT

1.5m

SPREAD

0.7m

HABIT

Reed-like tussock grass.

FORM

With upright form and strong architectural shape.

FLOWERS

Brown spherical head up to 2cm long from tip of leaf.



FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring to summer

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Tolerates drought & frost, and will also tolerate salt-spray, waterlogged areas and saline soils.

HORTICULTURE

Tough, fast growing and very hardy. Will grow in full sun or part shade and either wet or dry conditions in most soil types.
