

SPECIES Hemigraphis colorata

COMMON NAME Red Ivy, Red Flame Ivy, Waffle plant

ORIGIN Java

DESIGN USE Good groundcover or basket plant



HEIGHT

12-25cm

SPREAD

8-15cm

HABIT

A tropical showy species with shimmering silvery violet underneath red purple

FORM

This is a prostrate herb with rooting branches, opposite broad cordate and toothed leaves

FLOWERS

Small white flowers borne in terminal spikes up to 7cm long, with large, imbricate bracts.

VARIATIONS

"Exotica" (has crinkled leaves)

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Requires a temperature of 60-85°F, 16-29°C and a high humidity.

HORTICULTURE

Does best in full sunlight coming from the South/East/West and a soil that retains water yet drains well. Keep the soil evenly moist at all times and use warm water.
