HABIT

Fast growing perennial plant

FORM

Isolepsis is a dense clump with an upright to gently weeping sedge with deep green cylindrical foliage.

FLOWERS

Brownish-cream, globular flower heads

FLOWERING PERIOD

Through the year

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Isolepsis is ideal for full coastal exposure and can grow in sand dunes. Inland, it can handle cold and light frost to -5c.

HORTICULTURE

Thrives in full sun in a range of soils even waterlogged and saline soils. Tolerates salty spray and could be subjected to trimming to ground level every 2 to 3 years. Fertilize with slow release fertilizer after trimming.
