HEIGHT

SPREAD

0.4-1.2m x 0.2-1m

HABIT

Wetland species and tufts

FORM

Strongly evergreen rhizomatous perennial

FLOWERS

Culms terete, 25–90 cm long, 1.2–3.5 mm diam., ± hard, yellow-green; culm striations 38–90; pith mostly very interrupted. Pale yellow to mature bright yellow

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring–summer ends Autumn

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Medium frost tolerance. Planting near water protects from frost, however can withstand temperatures as low as -8°C once established for short periods. Tolerates periods of dry spells with temperatures extending from Mid 30's°C to Low 40's°C for short spells. Frost Tolerance: Medium. Coastal Tolerance: Medium. Drought Tolerance: Low

HORTICULTURE

Slow release low phosphorus fertilizer. Clay & Heavy Soil Tolerance: High / Wetlands
