Juncus fluvidus Yellow rush Australia



HEIGHT

SPREAD 0.4-1.2m x 0.2-1m

HABIT Wetland species and tufts

FORM Strongly evergreen rhizomatous perennial

FLOWERS

Culms terete, 25–90 cm long, 1.2–3.5 mm diam., \pm hard, yellow-green; culm striations 38–90; pith mostly very interrupted. Pale yellow to mature bright yellow

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring-summer ends Autumn

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Medium frost tolerance. Planting near water protects from frost, however can withstand temperatures as low as -8°C once established for short periods. Tolerates periods of dry spells with temperatures extending from Mid 30's°C to Low 40's°C for short spells. Frost Tolerance: Medium. Coastal Tolerance: Medium. Drought Tolerance: Low

HORTICULTURE

Slow release low phosphorus fertilizer. Clay & Heavy Soil Tolerance: High / Wetlands
