Lepironia articulata

Blue Rush

In wetlands from about Wollongong north into Queensland and the Northern Territory

Used extensively for planting in wetlands constructed for urban run-off management and for decorative ponds and lakes. It can be grown in a large pot or container in a home garden pond where it may end up being used as a launching pad for emerging dragonflies.



HEIGHT

40-200 cm upto 2.5m

SPREAD

2-10 mm diam

HABIT

Native grey green perennial. Hollow, cylindrical stems with basal sheathing scales

FORM

Stiffly erect, grey green clumps.

FLOWERS

Brown nut like flowers

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring to autumn

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

HORTICULTURE

Requires consistent, clear, deep water. Suitable for acid waters with low nutrient levels.
