An evergreen perennial with narrow deep green strap-shaped leaves that are curiously cut as though with pinking shears at the tips. Its light green, thick, strap-like leaves are accented by spiny flower spikes with tiny creamy yellow male flowers, lightly scented like sweet honey in the afternoon

### **CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**

Drought tolerant; Winter Hardiness:  $15-20^{\circ}$  F; Hardy to below  $20^{\circ}$  F - plants were undamaged in a landscape north of Atlanta, Ga. after a temperature was recorded of  $16^{\circ}$  F.

### **HORTICULTURE**

Full Sun, low water needs; It is tolerant of a wide range of conditions and requires little to no maintenance once established. Plant in full sun to moderate shade. It is drought tolerant once established but can also tolerate regular irrigation or even wet soils.
