<b>SPECIES</b>	Lomandra confertifolia 'Wingarra'
<b>COMMON NAME</b>	
<b>ORIGIN</b>	Australia
<b>DESIGN USE</b>	Mass planting. Foliage or grassy garden. Accent or border plant.



#### HEIGHT

30 – 40cm

#### SPREAD

40 – 50cm

#### HABIT

Very slow growing

#### FORM

Compact, clumping ornamental plant

#### FLOWERS

Masses of small, yellow, beautifully scented flowers that spread a sweet scent early morning and late afternoon.

#### FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring to Summer

#### CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Tolerates a wide range of climatic conditions. Full sun to part shade. Very hardy, excellent drought and frost tolerance. Frost tolerance to -10oC. Suited to coastal conditions.

#### HORTICULTURE

Plant in well mulched garden. Soil types should be sand loam and free draining clay loams and light clay. Fertilise once per year with a slow release fertiliser. Trim every 3-4 years to remove older leaves. Water well for the first 12 weeks until established. In extra dry climates, occasional top up watering may be required in the warmer months.
