**SPECIES** Lomandra longifolia 'Katrinus'

**COMMON NAME** Katrinus

**ORIGIN**

**DESIGN USE** Mass planting in garden beds and borders, for roadsides



#### HEIGHT

0.8–1m

#### SPREAD

1–1.2m

#### HABIT

It is a clumping perennial with medium growth rate and a uniform habit and is shorter than many forms of common Lomandra.



#### FORM

A soft weeping form of Lomandra longifolia with attractive, fine, deep green, strap like leaves.

#### FLOWERS

Yellow medium sized flower spikes held within the foliage.

#### FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring and summer



#### VARIATIONS

"Katrinus Deluxe" (finer leaf and larger flowers)

#### CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Evergreen in normal winters to 20° F (Zones 8-11) and grows well in inland climates where it can handle cold and frost to -7c with little leaf burn.

#### HORTICULTURE

Grows well in full sun and moderate to heavy shaded positions. Best suited for free draining, lightly acidic soils. It is best to avoid depressed areas that hold water. It tolerates windy, salt laden positions. Water is required to keep the plant healthy for the first few weeks but do not over water.
