COMMON NAME Tanika

ORIGIN

DESIGN USE Specimen or mass planting in gardens, roadsides, golf courses and good understory plant



HEIGHT

50–60cm

SPREAD

65cm

HABIT

Evergreen in almost all situations that does not grow too tall and has a weeping habit.

FORM

An improved compact fine leaf form of the popular Lomandra longifolia. This attractive deep green selection provides a graceful versatile plant.

FLOWERS

Attractive yellow flower head



FLOWERING PERIOD

Early in Spring

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Good for hot dry or humid areas and heavy frost cold areas. For most areas of Australia, Tanika is adaptable in most planting situations.

HORTICULTURE

Grows well in full sun and moderate to heavy shaded positions. It tolerates windy and salt laden positions. Water as required to keep the plant healthy for the first 8 to 13 weeks.
