| DESIGN USE | Border planting, groundcover or container plant, in and around water features |



HEIGHT

12 – 24" (30 – 61cm)

SPREAD

18 – 36" (46 – 91 cm)

HABIT

Mounded, compact growing habit.

FORM

Forms lime green tussocks to 1 foot tall and spreads slowly to an equal distance with very narrow 8 inch long leaves.

FLOWERS

Small spikes of cream flowers that bloom within the foliage

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring to summer

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Can tolerate light to moderate frosts. Hardiness degree at 15oF (-9.4oC). Ideally grown in full sun or part shade. Can be used on coastal areas.

HORTICULTURE

Generally requires filtered light and good drainage. Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Medium watering requirements tolerating dry conditions well although an occasional deep watering during extended heat is recommended. Will benefit from occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. No pruning is generally necessary although, if required, to rejuvenate foliage with fresh new growth - cut back to approx. 10cm from base in early spring or autumn. Feed in spring with a native formulated fertiliser.
