

SPECIES Viola hederacea
COMMON NAME Native violet

ORIGIN New South Wales, Queensland, Tasmania, Victoria and parts of Malaysia.

DESIGN USE Container plant, ground cover



HEIGHT

0.10m

SPREAD

0.20m

HABIT

Prostrate herb, the trailing stems root at the nodes to form a dense mat.

FLOWERS

White and violet flowers on stems to 15cm

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring/Summer

LEAVES

The leaves are bright green and kidney shaped to around 3cm across

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

It likes shade to moderate sun and plenty of moisture.

HORTICULTURE

Likes a moist but well drained, partly shady spot. It will tolerate full sun but not dry conditions.
