HEIGHT .08–1.5m (unsupported)

SPREAD 1.2–2m

#### HABIT

Compact rambler (shrubby climber) evergreen in the tropics, semi-dormant in cooler sub-tropics.

FLOWERS Yellow, bell-shaped to 6cm diameter

#### FLOWERING PERIOD Through most of the year in the tropics

LEAVES Whorled, to 6cm, glossy dark green

VARIATIONS "Silver Sunee" (solid metallic glaucous foliage)

## **CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**

Will tolerate almost any climate even long periods of dryness.

## HORTICULTURE

The cultivars prefer moist well drained soil with best flowering in full sun. However light shade appears to be beneficial in hot arid climates, and generous mulching essential.
