

SPECIES Bambusa vulgaris cv. Vittata

COMMON NAME Green Stripe Bamboo

ORIGIN Pantropical

DESIGN USE Large ornamental bamboo or use in containers or for bonsai.



## **HEIGHT**

Upto 15m

## **SPREAD**

Culm clump to 5m+ diameter, canopy to 15m+

#### **HABIT**

A robust, open clumping bamboo.

## **FLOWERS**

Tiny massed flowers after several decades signal the end of the clumps growth cycle.

### **LEAVES**

Slender deep green leaves arranged in graceful plumes.

#### **STEMS**

Culms reach 12cm diameter, deep gold with green stripes. New shoots are covered by black hairy sheaths.

# **CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**

It has proved to be fairly hardy, tolerating cool winters and moderate drought. Under stress, it defoliates but responds to ample watering.

## **HORTICULTURE**

Grows well in good soil and full sun. The expanding culms at ground level could soon raise the adjacent paving unless contained. Being an open clump it will need annual thinning to maintain control over the large amount of new growth produced each year.
