<b>COMMON NAME</b>	Creeping Gardenia, Cape Jasmine
<b>ORIGIN</b>	Asia
<b>DESIGN USE</b>	Border, edging, specimen plant, container plant, wall plant



**HEIGHT**  
0.30-0.50m

**SPREAD**  
.05m

**HABIT**  
Medium evergreen shrub with moderate growth rate and a fragrant flowering evergreen tropical plant, a favorite in gardens worldwide.



**FORM**  
Low growing, spreading, dense mound

**FLOWERS**  
Fragrant white blooms

**FLOWERING PERIOD**  
Summer to Autumn



**CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**  
Drought tolerant and may winter burn if exposed to cold and strong winds. Frost tender.

**HORTICULTURE**  
Propagated from softwood cuttings, semi-hardwood cuttings, and by simple layering. Best grown with full sun, part shade, well-drained soils. Protected positions (good against walls in cooler states).
