HABIT

Medium evergreen shrub with moderate growth rate and a fragrant flowering evergreen tropical plant, a favorite in gardens worldwide.

FORM Low growing, spreading, dense mound

FLOWERS

Fragrant white blooms

FLOWERING PERIOD

Summer to Autumn

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Drought tolerant and may winter burn if exposed to cold and strong winds. Frost tender.

HORTICULTURE

Propagated from softwood cuttings, semi-hardwood cuttings, and by simple layering. Best grown withj full sun, part shade, well-drained soils. Protected positions (good against walls in cooler states).
