Feature shrub or for screening, bird-attracting

HEIGHT 4m

SPREAD 2m

HABIT Rapid growing and showy tropical hybrid.

FORM Tall shrub with finely divided grey/green leaves.

FLOWERS Large pale cream/pink brush type flower heads.

FLOWERING PERIOD Most of the year

VARIATIONS

'Kay Williams' is a cultivar of G. Sandra Gordon x G. banksii.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Hardy and tolerant of coastal conditions. It will tolerate frosts once established.

HORTICULTURE

Hardy in a moist well drained soil in full sun. Pruning maintains denseness and encourages flowering.
