#### HABIT

Fast-growing, vigorous shrub with long, wide leaves.

### FORM

Large, open, dense shrub with glossy deep green leaves, silvery beneath.

## **FLOWERS**

The flowers are orange spider type which resembles the colour of orange marmalade. These are borne in short terminal racemes and styles in reddish-black colour with a thick covering of long brown hairs along full length of style, large tufts of brown and grey hairs at the base.

#### **FLOWERING PERIOD**

Most of the year

#### **CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**

This is basically a plant for subtropical and tropical regions. It is said to have a medium tolerance to drought. Frost tolerance is not good, and it does better in warmer climates.

#### HORTICULTURE

Best in moist well drained soil in full sun.
