SPECIES	Grevillea 'Sandra Gordon'
COMMON NAME	Sandra Gordon
ORIGIN	Australia hybrid
DESIGN USE	Good for cut flowers, accent shrub or for planters



HEIGHT

Shrub to 4m

SPREAD

HABIT

It is a fast-growing, very hardy and robust small tree. It is a very prolific flowering plant.



FORM

An open, tall shrub with long, fine gray-green foliage and bronze new growth.

FLOWERS

Bright yellow, toothbrush like flowers, which are produced in profusion over a long period, are 120mm long by 80mm wide. The styles, which are the colourful parts of the inflorescence, are about 30cm long.



FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring, may also appear in fall.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Frost tolerant with some protection.

HORTICULTURE

Place in direct sun and well-drained soils. Prune after flowering to maintain compact growth. Low maintenance with low moisture/fertilizer needs.
