<b>DESIGN USE</b>	Hedge, fence screen, groundcover, container plant



#### HEIGHT

1-3 m

#### HABIT

Open Forest and Gullies; Bird Attractor/Honey Eaters

#### FORM

upright, open shrub to 3m with drooping branches;ss



#### FLOWERS

Flowers are white, sometimes with a faint pink tinge. Long Flowering

#### FLOWERING PERIOD

Most months, mainly spring- July to October

#### HORTICULTURE

It grows in moist but well-drained soils, mostly sandy soils over sandstone; SHADY MOIST; SHADY DRY; Heavy & Clay Soil; Sandy
