

SPECIES Leptospermum juniperinum

COMMON NAME Prickly Tea tree
ORIGIN QLD and NSW
DESIGN USE Hedge and screen



HEIGHT

2-3m

HABIT

Very hardy, medium size plant develops like a tree

FORM

Upright and spreading variable tree.

FLOWERS

white -1cm dia, solitary

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring and early spring

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Forst hardy-tolerate frost to 7 deg. Cel.

HORTICULTURE

Suitable for poorly drained areas, best to position in a place at least few hours of direct sunlight, needs a light protection from winter or cold.
