DESIGN USE Ornamental grass in native and rock gardens

1-2m

1-2m

HABIT

Small shrub with soft fine foliage with claret coloured new growth. Growth rate is medium to fast.

FORM

Rounded shrub with ornamental bronze—coloured new foliage. Low, fine leaved hedging species 1-1.5m topped by reddish new growth.

FLOWERS

Flowers are white brush type mainly in summer.

FLOWERING PERIOD

Spring-summer

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Grows best in a sunny moist position. Frost sensitive when young.

HORTICULTURE

Full sun; grows in most soils; tolerates wetter sites. Susceptible to webbing caterpillar damage.
