



<b>SPECIES</b>	Orthrosanthus multiflorus
<b>COMMON NAME</b>	Morning Flag
<b>ORIGIN</b>	Australia and tropical America
<b>DESIGN USE</b>	Container plant, border or edge in massed plantings, or general garden beds



#### HEIGHT

0.60m

#### SPREAD

.050m

#### HABIT

Strappy-leaved perennial

#### FORM

A hardy tuft forming plant, with its fairly dense clump of strap-like evergreen foliage, it retains its attractiveness all year, making a nice foliage clump even when not in bloom.



#### FLOWERS

Purple iris-like or small sky blue flowers are borne above the foliage on stems repeatedly over the warmer months

#### FLOWERING PERIOD

Summer



#### CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Full sun to partial shade, drought tolerant. Will tolerate frost and drought conditions once established

#### HORTICULTURE

Prefers rich, well drained soil. Drought tolerant, only requiring an occasional deep watering during extended heat spells to keep it looking swell.
