HABIT

It is a slow growing, evergreen low shrub, up to 3 feet tall and wide

FORM

This plant grows very compact and in the shape of a mushroom cap. Unmatched by any other big-leafed tropical, this foliage plant plays an important role in creating jungle-like exotic compositions



FLOWERS

Cream or tan flowers. The flower is not showy. It gets creamy-white spathes in summer.

FLOWERING PERIOD

Summer

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Xanadu can grow in the garden in tropical and subtropical Australia and in warm temperate coastal areas. Prefers Light shade to part sun, Avoid afternoon sun

HORTICULTURE

Regular water, keep moist in summer, dryer in winter. Propagation is done by division of the plant.
