

SPECIES Pyrostegia ignea
COMMON NAME Flame Vine
ORIGIN South America

**DESIGN USE** For growing over a pergola or a sturdy fence



## HEIGHT

Upto 85 feet tall and attach themselves to their host by tendrils

## **SPREAD**

Attach themselves to their host by tendrils

#### **HABIT**

Evergreen, fast-growing and semi-deciduous tendril climber.

#### **FORM**

Spreading, climbing shrub

## **FLOWERS**

Large masses of orange to red tubular flowers form a brilliant display.

## **FLOWERING PERIOD**

October or on Winter

## **FRUIT**

Pod, 10 to 12 inches long

# **CLIMATIC TOLERANCES**

The blossoms often freeze in the colder part of its range, below 30° F (-1° C).

## **HORTICULTURE**

Fertile, well-drained soils in sunny places are preferred. It is propagated by cutting, layering, or seeds.
