HABIT A compact variety of Westringia fruticosa

FORM

A dense rounded shrub with narrow grey-green to dark green leaves

FLOWERS

Small white or purple flowers arising from the leaf axils.

FLOWERING PERIOD

Year round except in extreme heat or cold.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

A very hardy plant often found in coastal conditions. Adapts to a wide range of climates and well drained soils. Prefers full sun. Tolerant of frost, drought, salt spray and low nutrient soils.

HORTICULTURE

It will grow in most soil types and conditions, little fertiliser required. Extremely tough, Little summer watering is required when established. Can be pruned after flowering to maintain shape
