HABIT

It does not develop a trunk, as do some species of yucca, but it does produce multiple rosettes of leaves. It is slow-growing but will eventually form a clump with multiple rosettes.



FORM

Yucca Flaccida is a clump-forming, evergreen shrub. It features lovely green and gold strap like leaves that weep with age.

FLOWERS

The flower spikes reach 4 feet or more, carrying panicles of cream-colored, 2-inch-wide, bell-shaped flowers.



FLOWERING PERIOD

It blooms constantly during warm weather, but the flowers are open only in the morning.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Highly tolerant to drought and moderately tolerant to salt..

HORTICULTURE

Prefers a well-drained soil in full sun or part-shade.
