

SPECIES COMMON NAME ORIGIN DESIGN USE

Zingiber spectabile Beehive or Shampoo Ginger Asia Accent plant



HEIGHT 1.5-2.5m

SPREAD 1-2.5m

HABIT Medium tightly clumping ginger.

FLOWERS

Long-lasting cones of overlapping scalloped, waxy bracts, with small true flowers intricately spotted.

FLOWERING PERIOD

July to November

VARIATIONS

Flowerheads typically emerge yellow-gold ageing to red, but selected cultivars vary slightly in colour, size, shape and flowering time.

Z. macrodenium (Big Mac), has broader heads of brownish red bracts.

Z. ottensii (Borneo Red), a neat plant to 1.5m with smaller red flowerheads.

CLIMATIC TOLERANCES

Tolerates full sun in the humid tropics.

HORTICULTURE

Requires moist-fertile, well-drained soil, well-protected from drying winds.
